Intern Position at the Hill House

I. DESCRIPTION

CCSC Interns are employees of the CCSC (Consortium of Christian Study Center).

In partnership with the Hill House, this position serves the study center at University of Texas, Austin.

About the Consortium of Christian Study Centers: CCSC exists to catalyze and empower thoughtful Christian presence and practice at colleges and universities around the world, in service of the common good. It achieves this by facilitating the flourishing of existing study centers, encouraging the development of new study centers, and raising awareness of the study center movement.

About Hill House: exists to support students and faculty who are asking questions about God, discerning their sense of calling, and discovering how faith informs every area of life.

Accountability: The intern is accountable to the Internship Program Director of CCSC and to the Executive Director at the Hill House. The Directors will coordinate the supervision of the position.

Internship Partnership

- 1) Maintain CCSC-related communication and commitments
- 2) Fulfill communication responsibilities to CCSC Internship Director

Leadership Development

- 1) Participate in ongoing training and professional development opportunities as set forth by CCSC and Hill House.

Student Engagement & Hospitality

1. Offer hospitality and build meaningful relationships with students during weekly Tuesday Night Dinner & Discussion gatherings.

2. Engage with students during daily study hours at Hill House, providing support and cultivating community.
3. Oversee and mentor volunteer student teams responsible for study-hour hospitality and Tuesday night events.
4. Reside at Hill House and provide support, encouragement, and presence for residents, including participation in the weekly Sunday evening dinner and Compline prayer service.

Program Leadership & Facilitation

1. Help lead the weekly Public Reading of Scripture gatherings.
2. Co-facilitate the Just Show Up Book Club.
3. Attend and contribute to the planning team to develop and host monthly Film Forums.

Events & Community Life

1. Assist with the planning and execution of the annual residency retreat in August.
2. Support special social and academic events throughout the year, including holiday (Halloween and Christmas) and dance parties, cultural events, and on-campus programs such as Veritas Forums and Faculty Roundtable events in partnership with InterVarsity.

Team Collaboration

1. Participate in weekly staff meetings, contributing to program planning, organizational coordination, and community care.
